Add life, color and vitality to your outdoor scenes by adding people--such as pedestrians in street scenes, or figures in landscapes, seascapes or garden scenes! Active figures help animate and dramatize your paintings with color, focal points, movement and everyday activities.

Traditional and Impressionist approaches to rendering or suggesting people will be demonstrated, along with concepts of composition, color, and the effects of light and atmosphere; selecting and mixing colors on the palette and the canvas; and helpful studio tips.

- Artists of all levels are welcome, from beginner to professional.
- After demonstrating, the instructor will work with students individually.
- Demonstrations will be in oil. Artists are welcome to work in oil, acrylic, watercolor or gouache.

Katriel Srebnik's artwork has earned thirty-nine national awards, including First Place for Signature Members and three Awards of Excellence from the Oil Painters of America; the President's Award from the American Impressionist Society; First Place from the American Tonalist Society; Best of Show from the Academic Artists Association and Texas Art Museum; First Place from the National Society of Artists; has appeared in nearly all of the leading national art magazines; in over seventy national juried and eight museum exhibitions; and in galleries throughout the United States, in London and France, and his own galleries in Santa Fe and Charleston. He has taught workshops at over thirty art schools, colleges and other venues.

Interpreting figures, interiors and European scenes with light, atmosphere and expressive brushwork to evoke a mood and ambience, Srebnik creates his unique style, combining the spontaneity and immediacy of impressionism, the visual reality of painterly naturalism, and the poetic subtlety of tonalism.
